

1 Adopt 2 Cal. Code Regs. Section 18723.1 to read:

2 **§ 18723.1 Statements of Economic Interests: Public Officials with Multiple Positions.**

3 (a) A public official who holds multiple positions specified in Section 87200 shall only  
4 be required to file a single assuming office, leaving office, or annual statement of economic  
5 interests if the official's primary position specified in Section 87200 is required by law to serve  
6 in the additional position specified in Section 87200. Such a statement shall contain all  
7 reportable interests for all jurisdictions, be filed for the official's primary position, and list all of  
8 the official's additional positions for which the statement is submitted.

9 (b) Notwithstanding subdivision (a), if the official leaves the additional position on a  
10 different date than the official leaves the official's primary position, the official shall file a  
11 leaving office statement for that additional position under Regulation 18730.

12 (c) An official who holds a position identified in Section 87200 is not required to file an  
13 additional, separate statement of economic interest under the conflict of interest code of any  
14 agency with the same jurisdiction as, or a narrower jurisdiction than, the agency in which the  
15 official holds the Section 87200 position. Such an official, however, shall file an original  
16 statement, identical to the statement for the Section 87200 position, for each designated position  
17 with an agency with the same or a narrower jurisdiction than the agency in which the official  
18 holds the Section 87200 position.

19 (d) A designated employee required to file a statement under any other agency's conflict  
20 of interest code, or under Article 2 of the Act for a different jurisdiction, may expand the  
21 statement to cover all reportable interests in all jurisdictions, and file copies of the expanded  
22 statement with each agency in lieu of filing separate and distinct statements, provided that:

1           (1) With respect to an expanded statement submitted in paper format, each copy of the  
2 expanded statement filed in place of an original is signed and verified by the designated  
3 employee as if the copy is an original statement.

4           (2) With respect to an expanded statement submitted electronically through an electronic  
5 filing system approved by the Commission, each copy of the original electronically signed  
6 statement indicating the filing system’s System Acceptance Number (“SAN”) is filed in place of  
7 the original as if the copy is an original statement consistent with Regulation 18115.2(c).

8           (e) A county supervisor, city councilmember, planning commissioner, or a mayor may  
9 file with the Commission a single expanded annual statement for the official’s primary position  
10 specified in Section 87200 and for each additional designated position the official holds. An  
11 additional, separate statement need not be filed with each additional agency, if the expanded  
12 annual statement filed with each agency contains all reportable interests for all jurisdictions. The  
13 expanded annual statement shall indicate which financial interests are relevant to each position.

14           (f) An official specified in subdivision (e) may file a single expanded assuming office or  
15 leaving office statement for the official’s primary position specified in Section 87200 and each  
16 additional designated position if the official assumes or leaves each additional designated  
17 position on the same date as the official leaves the primary position. If the official assumes or  
18 leaves a designated position on a different date than the official assumes or leaves the official’s  
19 primary position, an assuming or leaving office statement shall be filed as provided in  
20 Regulation 18730.

21           (g) If an official specified in subdivision (e) also files the expanded statement described  
22 in subdivisions (e) or (f) with another agency, that expanded statement is not required to be

1 forwarded to the Commission.
