Honorable FPPC Commissioners:

I'm writing on behalf of the City Clerks Association of California (CCAC) to follow up on our previous communications regarding the implementation of AB 1170. We appreciate the work the FPPC has done so far to address some of the concerns we've raised, and we are grateful for the productive collaboration we've had with FPPC staff. That said, there are still a few outstanding issues we'd like to continue working together to resolve.

One of our primary concerns is the **public posting of all 87200 filings**. It was initially our understanding that all 87200 filings, including those from appointed officials such as city managers and planning commissioners, would be posted online. However, we have found that only filings from elected officials are currently available to the public, which limits transparency and public access.

Given that many local agencies have been making these filings publicly available, we strongly believe it is crucial for the FPPC to ensure all 87200 filings continue to be accessible online. This will help maintain consistency, improve public trust, and align with the transparency goals we all strive for.

We appreciate the improvements FPPC has made and the continued dialogue on other concerns. We remain committed to working together to resolve these remaining issues. We look forward to continuing our partnership with the FPPC to ensure the full and transparent implementation of AB 1170.
