These words shall <u>must</u> be presented in the same size and color as the 16 identification required by Section 84305, and shall must be immediately adjacent to and above or 17 immediately adjacent to and in front of the required identification unless otherwise specified by 18 statute. 19 (e) The requirements of Section 84305 to identify the name of the candidate or committee 20 sending a mass mailing apply to over 200 substantially similar messages distributed to the public 21 through electronic mail by a candidate or committee within a calendar month. 22 Note: Authority cited: Section 83112, Government Code.
