- 3 (a) The staff, under the direction of the Executive Director, shall seek to assure voluntary 4 compliance with the Political Reform Act and shall investigate possible violations of the Act. 5 The staff shall make reasonable efforts to first obtain the information requested in an 6 administrative subpoena on a voluntary basis by not serving an administrative subpoena less than 7 21 days after written communication is sent to the prospective recipient requesting voluntary 8 disclosure of information. prior to the issuance of an administrative subpoena. The Executive 9 Director, in the exercise of their discretion, may forego this procedure requesting voluntary 10 disclosure of information with respect to an investigation in progress. The staff shall periodically 11 report to the members of the Commission on the status of all investigations, including the 12 reasons for the issuance of any administrative subpoena without first making reasonable efforts 13 to obtain the information voluntarily. Failure to report to the Commission concerning the 14 issuance of subpoenas shall not affect the validity of any administrative subpoena.
 - (b) When <u>the staff</u> issues an administrative subpoena as provided in subdivision (a), the <u>subject recipient</u> of the subpoena must provide all records in their possession responsive to the subpoena. Any record(s) withheld based on objection must be accompanied by a description of the withheld record(s), which shall include the following information:
 - (i) the date of the record;

- 21 (iii) the identity of the recipient(s);
- 22 (iv) the specific ground for which the objection to produce the record is made; and
- (v) the current location of the record.
