- 5 file statements of economic interests pursuant to Government Code Sections 87200 et seq., if
- 6 they serve or expect to serve 30 days or more in any calendar year. Provided, however, that this
- 7 section shall not excuse these individuals from any filing obligations imposed by a conflict of
- 8 interest code adopted pursuant to Government Code Sections 87300 et seq.
- 9 (b) Retired judges who serve on assignment pursuant to Article VI, Section 6 of the
- 10 California Constitution shall file annual statements of economic interests pursuant to
