22	(B)(A) A "labor contract" is a contract or agreement reached through collective

3 (C)(B) A "personal employment contract" is a contract for employment, including the terms and conditions of employment, between the agency and an agency employee. 4 (D) Except as provided in subdivision (a)(3)(A), a contract between the agency and an 5 6 independent contractor is neither a labor agreement nor personal employment contract. 7 (b) "Pending." A proceeding involving a license, permit, or other entitlement for use has commenced and is considered pending only under the following circumstances: 8 9 (1) For an officer, a proceeding involving a license, permit, or other entitlement for use is 10 pending when: (A) The decision is before the officer for the officer's consideration.
