The Chair of the Fair Political Practices Commission may, at their discretion and in	
response to an emergency situation, extend the deadline for any public official who is required	d to
file an annual Statement of Economic Interests under Regulation 18723 or 18730 for a period	l of
up to 180 days past the deadline specified in those regulations. Notice of any such extension	
shall be in writing, effective immediately, and reported on a regular or special meeting agenda	a of
the Commission.	

For purposes of this section, "emergency situation" means a condition or degree of emergency as defined in section 8558 of the Government Code (California Emergency Services Act) that substantially impairs the ability of any public official to timely file a Statement of Economic Interests despite the exercise of reasonable diligence or the ability of any filing officer to timely receive and process Statements of Economic Interests.
