§ 18450.6. Disclosure on Advertisements in Languages Other than English.

(a) If an advertisement, as defined in Section 84501, appears primarily in a language other than English, whether written or spoken, the advertisement disclosure required by Article 5 of Chapter 4 must appear in that same language.

(b) Notwithstanding subdivision (a), a committee's name must be the same as the name used in the most recent Statement of Organization filed pursuant to Section 84101 or the name that a filer is required to use on campaign statements pursuant to subdivision (o) of Section 84211.
