(be) Electronic Media Advertisements on Social Media by a Political Party or Candidate 13 Controlled Committee for Elective Office: An advertisement subject to Section 84504.4(b) shall 14 include the required disclosure in a contrasting color that is easily readable by the average viewer 15 and in no less than 10-point font. 16 NOTE: Authority cited: Section 83112, Government Code.
