3	(a) A person who makes an enforceable promise to make a payment to or at the behest of
4	a candidate or committee makes a contribution to the candidate or committee, except to the
5	extent the person receives full and adequate consideration, and unless it is clear from the
6	surrounding circumstances that the enforceable promise is not made for political purposes.
7	(b) A person makes an "enforceable promise to make a payment," as that term is used in
8	subdivision (a), if he or she the person:
9	(1) Guarantees a loan.
10	(2) Furnishes security for a loan.
11	(3) Endorses a loan.
12	(4) Cosigns a loan.
13	(5) Makes and delivers a post-dated check.
14	(6) Establishes a line of credit at a bank or other commercial lending institution for a
15	candidate or committee.
16	(7) Promises in writing to make a payment for specific goods or services, and the
17	candidate or committee, based on the promise, expends specific funds or enters into an
18	enforceable contract with a third party.
19	(c) A person does not make an "enforceable promise to make a payment," as that term is
20	used in subdivision (a), if he or she the person signs a pledge card or similar document, agrees to
21	make installment payments through wire transfer, credit card transaction, debit account
22	transaction or similar electronic payment or otherwise agrees, orally or in writing, to make a

- (d) A candidate or committee shall report receipt of an enforceable promise to make a
 payment using the forms furnished by the Commission. This reporting shall be consistent with
 the requirements for reporting of contributions contained in chapter 4 (commencing with section
 84100) of title 9 of the Government Code.
