### 2024 Annual Form 700 Due March 3, 2025

(A late fine may be imposed if the statement is filed past March 3, 2025.)

Must use the FPPC's e-filing system and submit your Form 700 electronically.

- Judges (including pro tem judges who served 30 days or more during 2024) (Four hours or more constitutes one day served.)
- Court Commissioners

**Pro Tems:** Temporary or part-time court commissioners and pro tem judges must file annual statements if they served 30 days or more during 2024.

**Retired Judges:** You are not required to notify retired judges of their filing obligations. The FPPC notifies them, and they must file the statements directly with the FPPC e-filing system. Statements filed by retired judges will not be posted on our website.

**Please do not forward statements for filers covered under your court's conflict-of-interest code.**

Statements that are filed with the FPPC:

- **Continue to keep filers' information current in the system. Continue to monitor when assuming and leaving office statements should be filed electronically using the FPPC e-filing system.**
