**Appendix II**

**Regulations Incorporated into PRA Revision**

Select provisions from regulations interpreting the Political Reform Act have been incorporated into the PRA Revision. These minor additions are settled interpretations of the Act and do not involve major policy determinations. The few provisions included from regulation provide technical updates, give notice to filers of their obligations, add completeness, or make it easier to understand parts of the Act.

<b>18116</b> Reports and Statements; Filing Dates	<b>84404</b> Filing Dates for Reports and Statements; Weekend or Holiday Extension	Provides clear notice of filing deadlines.
<b>18117</b> Duties of Filing Officers and Filing Officials – Effect of Non-Compliance on Filing and Disclosure Obligations	<b>90231</b> Filing Officers’ and Filing Officials’ Duties – Effect of Noncompliance on Filing and Disclosure Obligations	Provides clear notice to filers about reports and statements.
<b>18215.1</b> Contributions; When Aggregated	<b>82017</b> Contributions; When Aggregated.	Added as a definition rather than repeated in § 85311 and regulation 18215.1; this way the same aggregation applies for limits and reporting purposes and for state and local.
<b>18225.7</b> Made at the Behest; Independent versus Coordinated Expenditures	<b>82015</b> Contribution or Expenditure; Made at the Request of or in Cooperation with a Candidate or Committee	Adding two sentences from this regulation assists in eliminating the confusing term “made at the behest” from the Act.
<b>18229</b> Inclusion of Registered Domestic Partners	<b>82071</b> Spouse	Updates the Act.
<b>18237</b> Definition of “Investment”	<b>82040</b> Investment	Technical updating of Act to include most Exchange Traded Funds as non-reportable, like mutual funds.
<b>18404</b> Termination of Candidate’s and Committee’s Filing Requirements	<b>82006</b> Candidate	Makes clearer in the statute the settled interpretation that the term “candidate” includes an elected officeholder.
<b>18426.1</b> Assistant Treasurer	<b>83105</b> Treasurer	Adds accepted provisions about assistant treasurer that are practical, noncontroversial and widely used.
<b>18427.1</b> Notification to Contributors of Filing Obligations	<b>83201</b> Notification to Contributors	Adds detail that major donor notice needs to be sent when a committee receives contributions <i>totaling</i> \$5,000 <i>in a calendar year</i> .

<b>18450.1</b> Definitions. Advertisement Disclosure	<b>87200</b> Advertisement; Definition	Minor clarifications to statutory definition of advertisement in current § 84501.
<b>18616.4</b> Reports by Lobbying Coalitions which are Lobbyist Employers; Reports by Members of Lobbying Coalitions	<b>82047</b> Lobbying Coalition <b>90000</b> Registration <b>90004</b> Lobbyist Employer; Lobbying Coalition; Registration Requirements	Adds lobbying coalitions for completeness and to notify lobbying coalitions of registration obligations.
<b>18729</b> Leasehold Interests – Value, Disclosure	<b>89207</b> Disclosure of Leasehold Interests	Adds disclosure of leasehold interests, a type of interest in real property, for completeness and notice to SEI filers.
<b>18941</b> Receipt, Promise, Acceptance, and Return of Gift	<b>88101</b> Receipt and Acceptance of Gift	Adds one sentence from regulation 18941 as to when an official “receives” or “accepts” a gift.
<b>18945</b> Source of Gifts	<b>88102</b> Source of Gift; Use of Intermediary or Agent; Disclosure Requirements	Adds sentence from regulation 18945 that the person who makes the gift is the source of the gift, unless acting as an intermediary or agent.
<b>18996</b> Scope of Audits and Investigations	<b>90303</b> Audits and Investigations - Timing and Scope	Restoring to statute notice to filers on what is subject to audit.
