Dear Mr. Hoye:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act").¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the Secretary of State's Office regarding an outstanding annual fee payment for the year of 2014.

The Enforcement Division found that the Committee for the California Human Rights Amendment, sponsored by the California Civil Rights Foundation did not meet the financial threshold to qualify as a committee and therefore would not be required to pay annual fees. Additionally, the Committee has terminated with the Secretary of State's office and local filing officer and has no previous history with the Enforcement Division. As a result, we will not pursue any enforcement action on this matter.
