The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ This letter is in response to a referral from the County of Placer regarding your failure to timely file a 2018 Annual Statement of Economic Interests (“SEI”).

The Enforcement Division found that you filed the missing statement on August 30, 2019, before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division. In addition, you also filed your Leaving Office SEI.
