The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act¹ (the “Act”). This letter is in response to a referral from the Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk alleging that you failed to timely file a Officeholder/Candidate Campaign Statement (Form 470) for your position as School Board Member with ABC Unified School District. The Form 470, covering the period January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, was due by July 31, 2021.

The Enforcement Division found that you filed the missing report on November 3, 2021 before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division.
