No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC No. 2022-00992; Ryan Galbraith

Dear Mr. Galbraith:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).¹ As you are aware, the Enforcement Division received a referral from the Commission’s Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit alleging that you failed to timely file your Assuming Office SEI for your position as an Alternate Member for the Northern CA Community Colleges SIA.

You have since explained that you were not notified by the school district you work for that they had designated you as an Alternate Member and you have not attended any meetings. You have since filed the missing SEI. For these reasons, we are closing this matter without further action.
