**No Action Closure Letter re: FPPC Case No. 2023-00674; Gilbert Otero**

Dear Gilbert Otero:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission (“FPPC”) enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the “Act”).<sup>1</sup> This letter is in response to a referral from the FPPC’s Statements of Economic Interests (“SEI”) Unit regarding your failure to timely file your 2022 Annual SEI for your position as District Attorney for the County of Imperial.

The Enforcement Division found that you timely filed your 2022 Annual/Leaving Office SEI with the County of Imperial. However, the County failed to timely forward the SEI to the FPPC’s SEI Unit. Since you timely filed your 2022 Annual/Leaving Office SEI with the County, we are closing this matter without further action.
