**Re: No Action Closure Letter
FPPC No. 2019-00167; Lenora Ingram**

Dear Ms. Ingram:

The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act¹ (the "Act"). As you are aware, the Enforcement Division received a referral from the California Department of Rehabilitation alleging that you failed to timely file a 2017 Annual Statement of Economic Interests ("SEI") for your position as a Rehabilitation Supervisor.

After you were contacted by the Enforcement Division, you called to explain that you are currently out on military leave and have been since March 2018. Regulation 18723, subsection (e), states that if a person reports for military service, the deadline to file the annual SEI is 30 days following his or her return to office. For this reason, we are closing this matter without further action. Please file your 2017 Annual and 2018 Annual SEIs within 30 days of returning to your position at the Department of Rehabilitation.
