The Enforcement Division of the Fair Political Practices Commission ("FPPC") enforces the provisions of the Political Reform Act (the "Act"). <sup>1</sup> As you are aware, the Enforcement Division received a referral from the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation regarding your failure to timely file a 2018 Annual Statement of Economic Interests ("SEI") as a Staff Psychiatrist for California Correctional Health Care Services.

The Enforcement Division sent you a letter on February 5, 2020. You immediately responded to our letter and explained that you left office in 2019 and had already filed your 2018 Annual SEI and your Leaving Office SEI. The Enforcement Division has since received copies of your SEIs, which were filed in July 2019, which was before you were contacted by the Enforcement Division.
